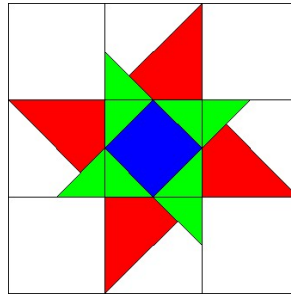


Double Spin Star

Block #12



Note: Colors are relative, use whatever colors you'd like. Your blocks should measure close to 12½" X 12½" and 6½" X 6½". Sizes for 12" blocks are listed first, sizes for 6" blocks are listed second and in italics. rst = right sides together

Cutting Instructions:

Background:

2—5½" X 5½"; 4—4½" X 4½"
 2—3½" X 3½"; 4—2½" X 2½"

Red:

2—5½" X 5½"
 2—3½" X 3½"

Green:

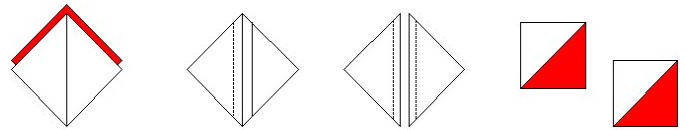
8—2½" X 2½"
 8—1½" X 1½"

Blue:

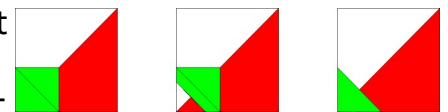
1—4½" X 4½"
 1—2½" X 2½"

Block Construction:

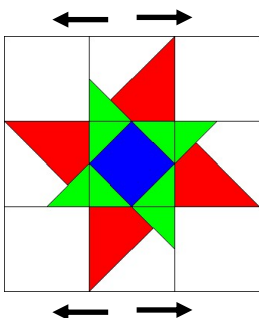
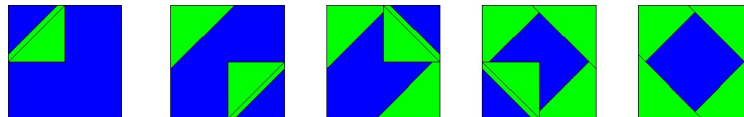
Mark the diagonal on the wrong side of the 2 larger background squares. Lay rst on a red square. Stitch ¼" on each side of the drawn line. Press toward the red. Square up to 4½" X 4½" (2½" X 2½").



Mark the diagonal of all green squares. Set four aside. Lay the others rst on the half square triangle you just made as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim the outer edge of the green square. Press the remaining portion of the green square out. Set aside.



Lay a green square rst on the blue square. Stitch along the drawn line. Trim the outer portion of the green square as you did above. Continue adding green squares as shown below. It's important add them as shown so the section does not get miss shaped.



Use all sections made and the background squares to create the block. Press seams open unless indicated by the arrows.
