Fabric Requirements

6 1/2" X 6 1/2" Dark Woven Fabric
3 1/2" X width of fabric Light/Tan Fabric

Wool Requirements

5 1/2" X 10 1/2" Gold for sunflowers
5" X 6" Grey for machine
3" X 3" Brown for flower centers
2" X 3 1/2" Green for leaves
1 1/2" X 4 1/2" Blue for flowers
2" X 9" Brown Texture for window box
2 1/2" X 8" Brown for window trim
2" X 6" White texture for window panes
1" X 1" Red for pincushion

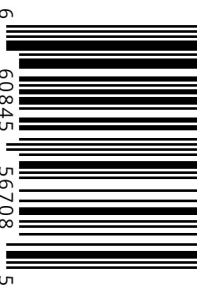
Fusible Web—I like Steam A Seam Lite
Valdani pearl cotton size 12 to match wools used
3 small ivory buttons

Woolly Window Box

Sew Beautiful Sunflowers

10" X 10" Finished

Dark Fabric & Light/Tan Border

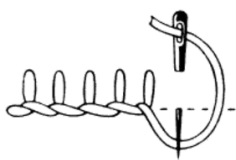
6½" X 6½" Dark center

2—3" X 6½" Side borders; 2—3" X 11½" Top & bottom borders

Apply borders to create the base for the applique. Press toward borders. Set aside

Applique

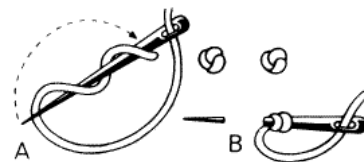
- ✂ Trace the templates from the diagram onto the paper side of fusible web, leaving approximately ⅛" between tracings.
- ✂ Referring to the fusible web manufacturer's instructions, press the fusible web to the wrong side of the appropriate/color wool. All drawings are reversed for your convenience.
- ✂ Cut out each shape on the drawn lines, then remove the fusible web backing when you're ready to adhere the shapes to the fabric base. Use the cover photo for placement.
- ✂ Most pieces are stitched down using a buttonhole stitch. Use a straight stitch for the sunflower petals, thread on spool and pins. Use stem stitch for thread, sewing machine swirl, leaf veins. French knots are used for pin heads
- ✂ Add buttons to the blue flower centers.
- ✂ Trim to 10½" X 10½". Finish as you choose! You can fuse a backing and button hole around the outer edge, or layer with batting and backing. Quilt around the window and window box. Add binding of your choice. This block can also be put together with blocks from the other designers involved (see list of designers on pattern back).

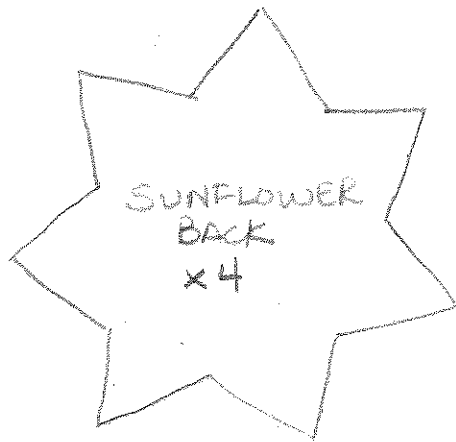

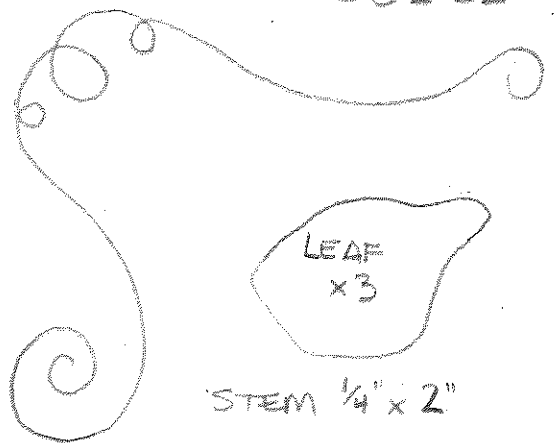

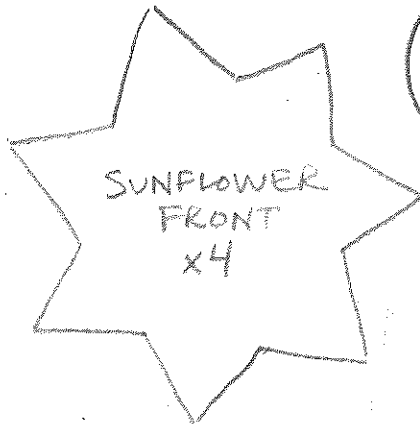

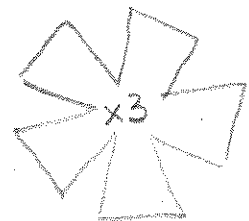
