Fabrics:
12 1/2" X 12 1/2" Light for background

Wool
7" X 10" Cream/white
4" X 4" Red #1
2" X 7 1/2" Light Blue
2 1/2" X 5" Dark Blue
2 1/2" X 4" Gold
1" X 4" Black
1" X 4" Brown
1" X 1 1/2" Red #2
3/8" X 26" Green #1
3/8" X 8" & 1" X 2 1/4" Green #1
3/8" X 6" & 1" X 1 1/4" Green #2

1/4 yard fusible (I like Steam A Seam Lite II)
Size 12 perle cotton to match wools (I like Valdani)

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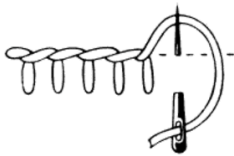


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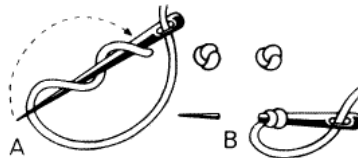
Finished Block Size 11" X 11"

Applique

- ✂ Trace the templates onto the paper side of fusible web, leaving approximately 1/8" between tracings.
- ✂ Cut out each shape just outside the drawn lines.
- ✂ Referring to the fusible web manufacturer's instructions, press the fusible web to the wrong side of the appropriate color wool. All drawings of 'parts' are reversed for your convenience.
- ✂ For heart stripes (red #2) and flower stems (green #1 & #2) cut a strip of fusible to the sizes indicated on the diagram page. Fuse to the appropriate wool. Trim each strip to 1/4" X the length listed. Once you peel the paper backing off you can 'bend' the strips to the desired shapes while pressing in place.
- ✂ Cut out each shape on the drawn lines, then remove the fusible web backing when you're ready to adhere the shapes to the background fabric.
- ✂ Use the diagram page for layout. Please note that the image is not the complete design but enough to help you with placement.
- ✂ Most pieces are stitched down using a buttonhole stitch. The stems are stitched with Xs. The 2 smaller gold stars are stitched down with long straight stitches from the center to the outer points and inside star edge. Bee stripes/antennas, 3 small blue stars and blue flower accents are made with long straight stitches. Star accents are made with French Knots. The bee 'pathes' are made with a running stitch.



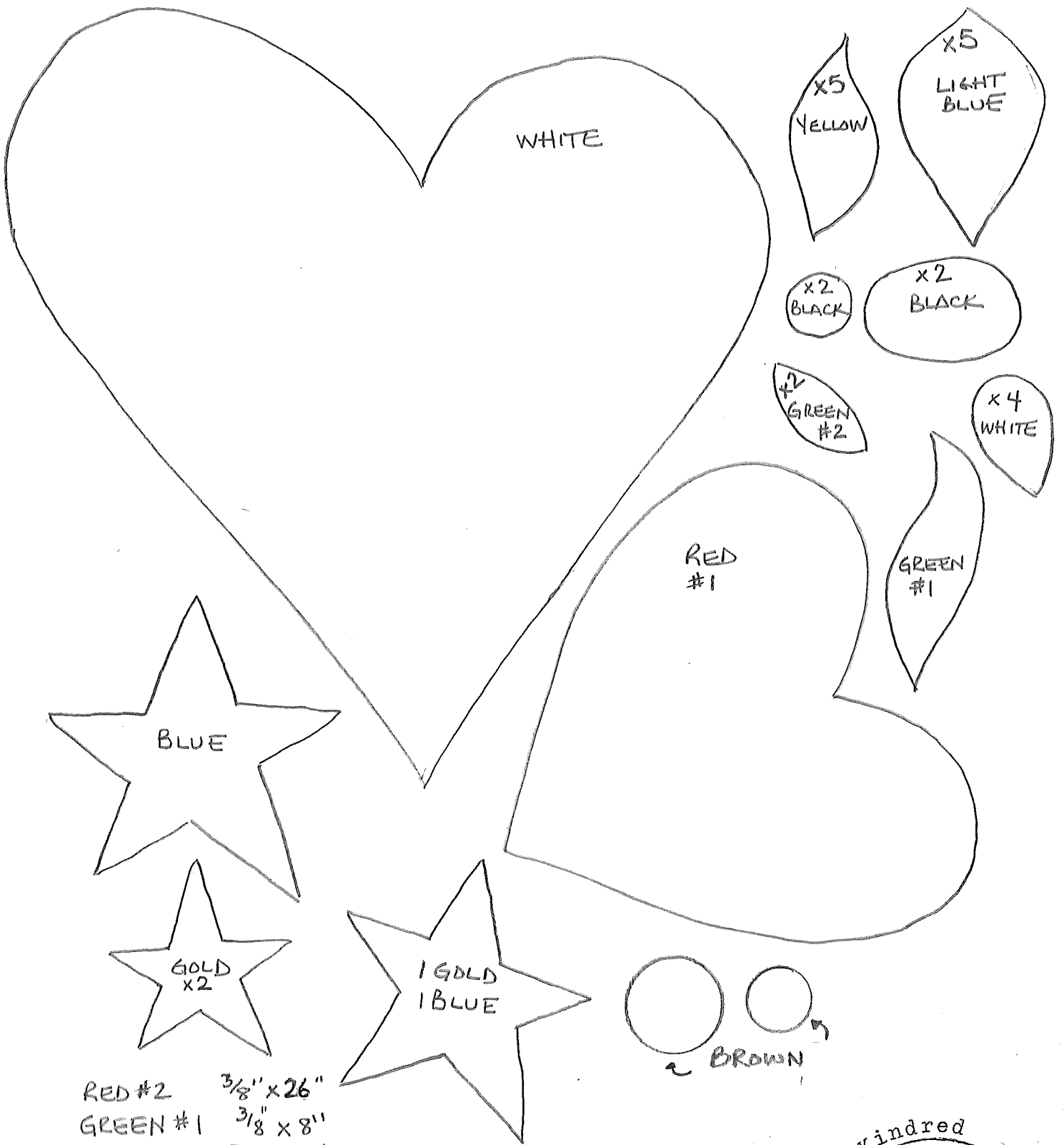
Buttonhole Stitch
