


Applique

Trace the templates onto the paper side of fusible web, leaving approximately $\frac{1}{8}$ between tracings.

- > Cut out each shape just outside the drawn lines.
- Referring to the fusible web manufacturer's instructions, press the fusible web to the wrong side of the appropriate color wool. All drawings of `parts' are reversed for your convenience.
- For heart stripes (red #2) and flower stems (green #1 & #2) cut a strip of fusible to the sizes indicated on the diagram page. Fuse to the appropriate wool. Trim each strip to ¼" X the length listed. Once you peel the paper backing off you can 'bend' the strips to the desired shapes while pressing in place.
- Cut out each shape on the drawn lines, then remove the fusible web backing when you're ready to adhere the shapes to the background fabric.
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- Most pieces are stitched down using a buttonhole stitch. The stems are stitched with Xs. The 2 smaller gold stars are stitched down with long straight stitches from the center to the outer points and inside star edge. Bee stripes/antennas, 3 small blue stars and blue flower accents are made with long straight stitches. Star accents are made with French Knots. The bee 'pathes' are made with a running stitch.
