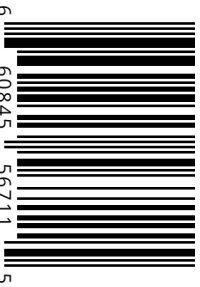

Fabric Requirements

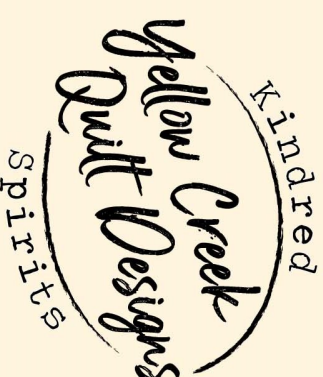
- 5/8 yard cream for background of applique and pieced border
- (1) 2 1/2" X 22" each of a gold, two reds, two greens, two blues for pieced border
- 1/4 yard red for binding
- 5 1/2" X 15" red wool for W, e, m, and e
- 3 1/2" X 10" white wool snowman, snow on trees & snowflakes
- 4" X 5 1/2" green #1 wool for tree bottom and middle
- 3 1/2" X 5 1/2" green #2 wool for tree top and middle
- 1 1/2" X 1 1/2" brown wool for tree trunk
- 3 1/2" X 4 1/2" grey wool for moon and mitten cuffs
- 2 1/2" X 3" green #3 for holly leaves
- 2" X 3" gold wool for star
- 2 1/2" X 3" black/white wool for scarf
- 2" X 2 1/2" red #2 wool for snowman heart
- 2" X 2 1/2" blue wool for mittens
- 1" X 2" orange wool for nose
- 1/2 yard backing
- 2—micro black buttons for snowman eyes
- 6—micro red buttons holly berries

rst = right sides together
hst = half square triangle

Applique Preparation and Cutting Instructions

- ◆ Trace the templates onto the paper side of fusible web, leaving approximately ⅛" between tracings.
- ◆ Cut out each shape just outside the drawn lines.
- ◆ Referring to the fusible web manufacturer's instructions, press the fusible web to the wrong side of the appropriate—colored wools.
- ◆ Cut out each shape on the drawn lines, then remove the fusible web backing when you're ready to adhere the shapes to the quilt top.

Cutting Instructions

From cream for background of applique & pieced border

1—24½" X 10½" for applique background

16—1¾" X 2" for border hst units

36—2" X 2¼" for border hst units

From a variety of each a gold, two reds, two greens, two blues

for pieced border for pieced border you will need the following totals:

32—2" X 2"

16—1¾" X 1¾"

From red for binding

3—2¼" X wof

From red wool cut:

1 each of letters W, e, m and e

From winter white wool cut:

1 of snowman

1 of each snow on tree

3 of snowflake

From green #1 wool cut:

1 each of tree bottom and tree second from top

From green #2 wool cut:

1 each of tree top and tree second from bottom

From brown wool cut:

1 of tree trunk

From grey wool cut:

1 of moon

2 each of mitten cuffs

From green #3 wool cut:

4 each holly leaves

From gold wool cut:

1 star

From black/white wool cut:

1 each of scarf pieces

From red #2 wool cut:

1 snowman heart

From blue wool cut:

1 each of mitten

From orange wool cut:

1 of nose

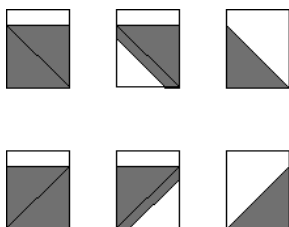
Sewing Instructions

Referring to the project photo for placement, fuse wool to the cream $24\frac{1}{2}$ " X $10\frac{1}{2}$ ". (You'll trim this to the size of your pieced borders, you'll make below, minus the corner rectangles.) Stitch the pieces using a buttonhole stitch. The snowman arms and mitten string are stitched using a chain stitch. The scarf tassels are straight stitches. Set aside.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the variety of darks 2 " X 2 ".

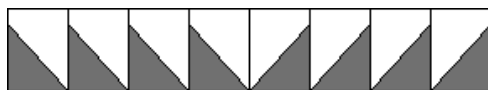
Place these squares right sides together on $32-2$ " X $2\frac{1}{4}$ " cream as shown below. Stitch on the drawn line, trim the outer portion of the square to reduce bulk, leaving the rectangle uncut to allow a straight piece should your square not be sewn/stitched exactly. Using a rectangle instead of a creating regular half square triangles gives you a little more room on the outer edge to square your piece after quilting and not risk cutting off points.

Make a total of 16 units following the top diagram below and an additional 16 units as in the bottom diagram below.

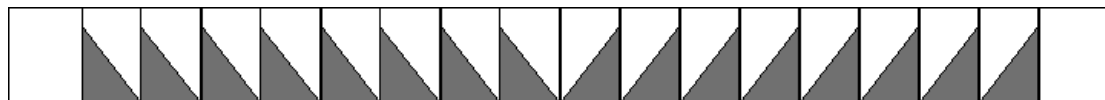


Repeat the steps from above with a variety of $1\frac{3}{4}$ " dark squares and $1\frac{3}{4}$ " X 2 " cream rectangles. Make a total of eight units like the top diagram above and eight units like the bottom diagram above.

Sew eight units from just above to make a side border as shown below. Repeat to make a second side unit.

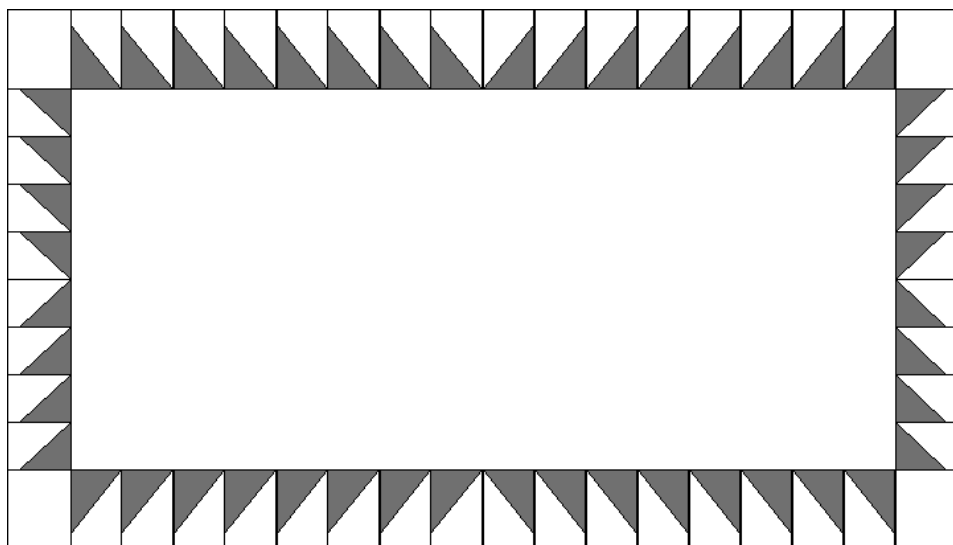


Sew 16 units from the first steps to make a top border as in the diagram below. Sew a 2 " X $2\frac{1}{4}$ " cream rectangle to each end to complete a top border. Repeat to make a bottom border.



Stitch the side borders to the applied rectangle. Press toward the center. Stitch the top and bottom borders to the project. Press toward the center.

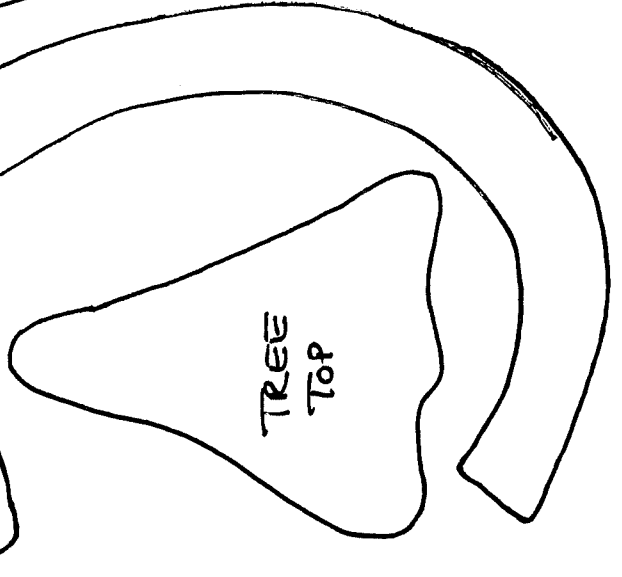
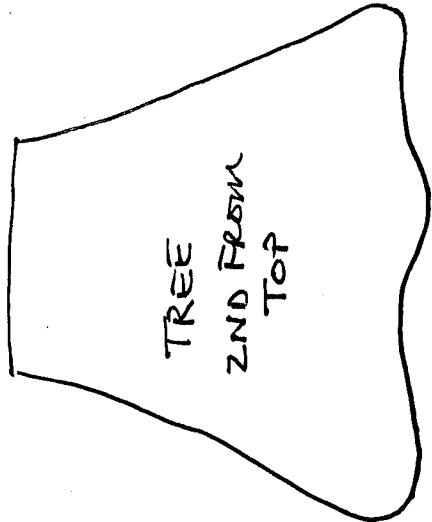
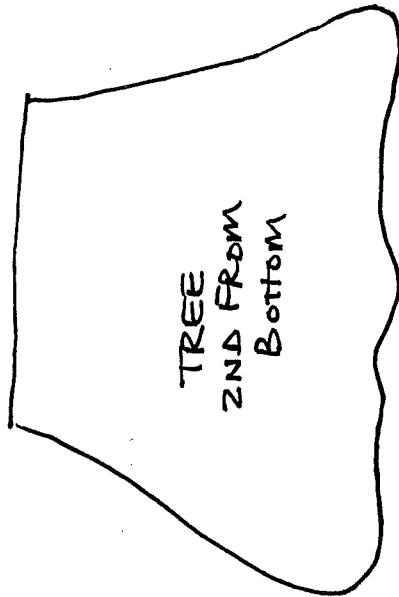
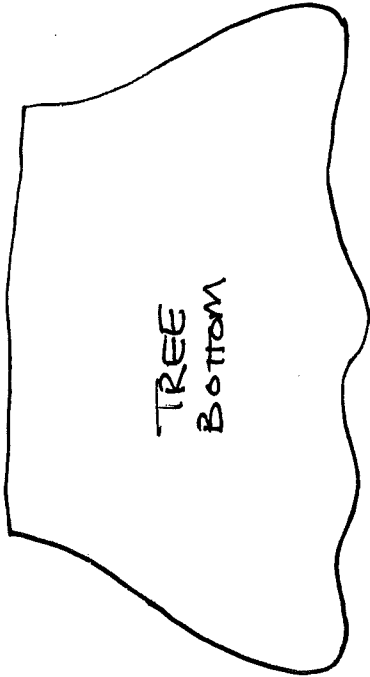
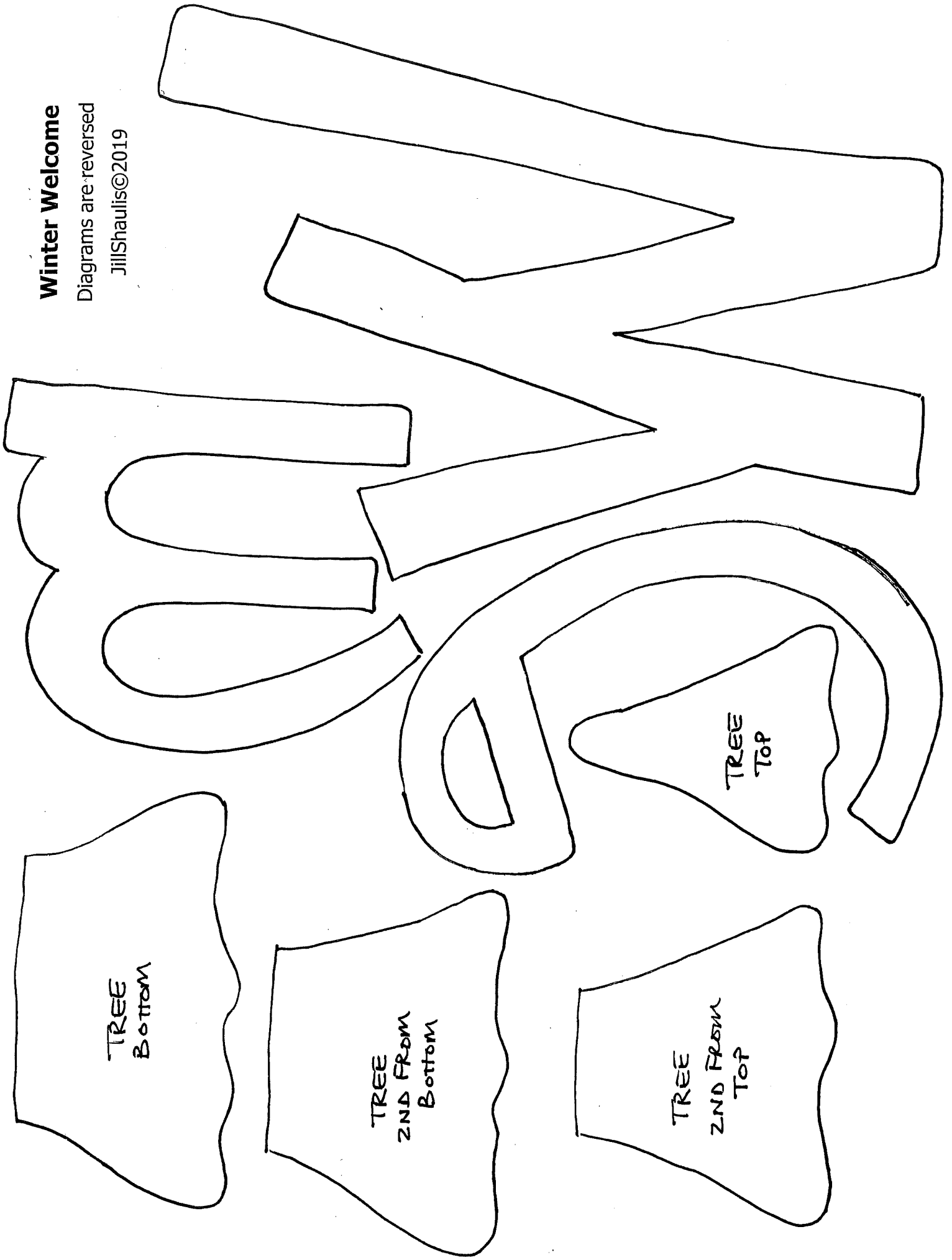
